

Marriage License Between William Read & Lydia Gould Of Aldbourne Dated 20th January 1836

Charles James, by Divine Permission, Lord Bishop of LONDON, TD our well-beloved in Christ, William Read of the Parish of Aldbourne in the County of Wilts a Bachelor and Lydia Gould of the Parish of Saint Leonard Shoreditch in the County of Middlesex a Spinster

SENDETH GREETING. Phereas ye are, as is alleged, determined to enter into the holy state of Matrimony,

and are very desirous of obtaining your Marriage to be solemnized in the Face of the Church, we are willing that such your honest Desires may more speedily have their due effect; and therefore, that ye may be able to procure such Marriage, to be freely and lawfully solemnized in the Parish Church of Saint Leonard Shoreditch aforesaid by the Rector, Vicar, Curate, or Officiating Minister thereof, without the Publication or Proclamation of the Banns of Matrimony, provided there shall appear no impediment of Kindred or Alliance, or of any other lawful Cause, nor any Suit commenced in any Ecclesiastical Court to bar or hinder the Proceedings of the said Matrimony according to the tenor of this Licence; and that the said Marriage be openly solemnized in the Church above mentioned, between the hours of Eight and Twelve in the Forenoon; \mathfrak{We} do hereby, for good Causes, give and grant our Licence of Faculty, as well to you the parties contracting, as to the Rector, Vicar, Curate, or Officiating Minister, of the said Church , where the said marriage is intended to be solemnized, to solemnize the same in Manner and Form above specified according to the Rites and ceremonies prescribed in the Book of Common Prayer, in that behalf published by Authority of Parliament: Diven under the Seal (which we use in this behalf) the twentieth Day of January Six in the year of our Lord On Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty and Year of our Translation. eightieth in the Jos.
