

Three Children are recorded in his attestation papers all born before his marriage. 1. Grace Eleanor, born 4th May 1908 at Soley, Hungerford; 2. Mabel Lilian, born 17th July 1910 at Aldbourne; 3. Wilfred Ernest, born 5th May 1913 at Aldbourne.										
The 1911 census records Ernest & Ellen as married but this was not the case.
