1805

A young POINTER DOG, strong made, very active, marked all over his body with large and small yellow spots, the inside of his mouth dark brown; answers to the name of Dow. Whoever has found the above Dog, and will bring him to Mr Fort, either in Salisbury, or at Alderbury, shall receive HALF A GUINEA Reward, and be paid all expenses. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 1 April 1805**

1821
