Whereas on Sunday the 26th of June, in the Night-Time, some cruel and malicious Person or Persons went into the Grounds of Mrs. Moody, of the Parish of Alderbury, and barbarously cut the throats of two horses and one cow, to the great Injury and concern of the said Mrs. Moody: This is to give Notice, that whosoever will discover the Offender or Offenders, shall, upon Conviction of one or more of them, receive ten Guineas Reward from the said Mrs. Moody: And, as a further Encouragement to bring such Villains to Justice, the Farmers and principal Inhabitants of Alderbury aforesaid, have also agreed to give ten Guineas, over and above the Reward offered by Mrs. Moody. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 22 August 1763**
