Warminster Police Court, Friday Before Captain Helme and the Rev. W. Hickman. John Roberts, a tramp, was brought up on remand charged with stealing a pair of boots, value 5s., the property of Alfred Rowe, of Upton Lovell, on the 25th August, and sentenced to a month's imprisonment. He was further charged with stealing a quantity of articles, value 4s. 6d., from the house of George Northover, at Whaddon, but the case was dismissed.
