COOK, HOWARD Rifleman S/28492 - 3rd Battalion, Rifle Brigade (The Prince Consort's Own) - Died 31st July 1917 - Aged 21 - Born in Alderton; Resident of Bristol, Gloucestershire; Enlisted at Bristol, Gloucestershire; Son of Thomas John & Florence Cook of Little Stoke, Patchway, Bristol, Gloucestershire - Commemorated on the Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial reference: Panel 46-48 and 50

GODWIN, PERCY JASPER GARLAND - Private 30834 - 5th Battalion Dorsetshire Regiment - Died 27th September 1918 - Born in Alderton; Resident of Box; Enlisted at Devizes - Buried at Chapel Corner Cemetery, Sauchy-Lestree, Pas de Calais, France - Grave/Memorial Reference C.36

GODWIN, WILLIAM FREDERICK - Private 21325 - 6th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 7th June 1917 - Aged 21 - Born in Alderton; Resident of Chippenham; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Mary Jane Godwin and the late Frederick Godwin of 52, Rodwell, Hilmarton - Commemorated on Ypres (Menin Gate) Memorial, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial reference: Panel 53

COPELAND, GEORGE - Sergeant/ Air Gunner 622353 - 100 Squadron, Royal Air Force - Son of George and Mabel Copeland of Chippenham, Wiltshire - Died 31 July 1944 - Age 23 - Buried in Haverskerque British Cemetery, Nord, France - Grave/Memorial reference: Row B. Grave 18.

CROSSLEY, JACK - Trooper 7934592- 8th King's Royal Irish Hussars, Royal Armoured Corps - Died 1st December 1941 - Age 31 - Son of Frank and Mary Crossley; Husband of Annie Crossley of Alderton, Wiltshire - Buried in Knightsbridge War Cemetery, Acroma, Libya - Grave/Memorial reference: 10. G. 25.

HULANCE, FRED - Gunner 75263 - 2nd Depot, Royal Garrison Artillery - Died 27 May 1917 - Aged 26 - Born in Alderton; Resident of Maiden Bradley; Enlisted at Warminster; Son of Thomas and Emily Hulance of Alderton; Husband of Ellen Louisa Hulance of 52 Maiden Bradley - Buried in Maiden Bradley (All Saints) Churchyard, Maiden Bradley - Grave/Memorial reference: None Recorded

MONK, FRANK - Private 18209 - 5th Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment - Died 9 April 1916 - Aged 25 - Born in Grittleton; Resident of Alderton; Enlisted at Devizes; Son of Thomas Monk of Alderton Road, Grittleton Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq - Grave/Memorial reference: Panel 30 and 64.

MONK, JACK (JOHN) - Lance Corporal 20121 - 8th Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment - Died 15th September 1916 - Born in Littleton Drew; Resident of Littleton Drew; Enlisted at Bristol, Gloucestershire - Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial reference: Pier and Face 2C.

STYLES, JACK (JOHN) - Private 6484 - 1st Battalion Coldstream Guards - Died 14th September 1914 - Born in Corston; Resident of Alderton; Enlisted at Malmesbury - Buried in Valley British Cemetery, Aisne, France - Grave/Memorial Reference: I. B. 28.

STYLES (STILES), WALTER - Private 18251 - 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 18th October 1916 - Born in Christian Malford; Resident of Chippenham; Enlisted at Devizes; Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial reference: Pier and Face 13A. (This is a tentative suggestion for the casualty listed as Walter Styles on the memorial situated in St. Giles Church, Alderton there is no further defining criteria)

WATTS, GORDON - There is no defining criteria to confirm the details of this casualty
