Allington, All Cannings



Allington, near Devizes, is a parish and village situated 5 miles north-east of Devizes, 11 south-west of Marlborough, in the Swanborough Hundred, diocese of Sarum, and the division and Union of Devizes; it is also a tithing in the parish of All Cannings, and within the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of that place, but a separate parish for the management of its parochial affairs. It contains 1,158 acres of land, and a population of 190. Here is a chapel for the Baptists, and a Free school supported by that denomination. The Earl of Ilchester is Lord of the Manor.
