Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes

1818

On Tuesday last Stephen Burton, of Alvediston, servant of Mr. King, was sentenced to one month's imprisonment in the house of correction at Devizes, for not properly threshing corn.

1828

Thomas Selwood, for one month, for leaving the service of Mr. Rogers of Alvediston.

Committed to the New Prison, Devizes

1838

James Gough, for one month, for leaving the service of J. W. G. Rogers of Alvediston.

Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 3 May 1838

1840

John Holland, 2 months, destroying game at Alvediston.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 6 January 1840

1841

Josiah Ellis, 14 days, for leaving the service at Alvediston.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 24 May 1841

William Roberts, 1 month, leaving service at Alvediston.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 20 December 1841

1842

Sarah Roberts, for three months, and Harriet Roberts, for one month, (sisters) for vagrancy at Alvediston.

Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 21 July 1842

James Snook, 3 months, destroying game at Alvediston.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 10 October 1842

1843

George Shergold of Alvediston, for one month for destroying game in this parish.

Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 23 February 1843

Committed to the County Gaol

1849

William Adlam, of Alvediston, one month for the non-payment of a bastardy order.
