Alvediston

Committed to the County Gaol

1850

William Price , of Bristol, for stealing a great (coat), the property of Elias Young, at Alvediston.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 14 September 1850

1852

Alfred Pole, of Alvediston, seven days, for misbehaviour in service.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 15 May 1852

1853

William Coombs, of Alvediston, and Andrew Rudge, of Dinton, for one month each, for leaving their service.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 23 July 1853

1856

George Field pleaded guilty to stealing a jacket, the property of George Adlam, at Alvediston, and was sentenced to three months hard labour.
