Wiltshire Quarter Sessions - John Williams, a labourer, was sentenced to four months for breaking a window and stealing 44 gold rings at Swindon on April 9; whilst for breaking into a house at Alvediston on May 14, and stealing cigarettes, whisky, and money at Berwick St John...sentenced to imprisonment for 12 months.
