Alvediston Man Involved In Two Assaults

Hindon Petty Sessions, Wednesday.

Before R. Graves, Esq. (chairman), Lord Arundell, J. Locke, Esq., V. Bennett-Stamford, Esq., and T. F. Grave, Esq., M.P.

Henry Poole and Henry Coombes were summoned for assaulting Geo. Wm. Mullins, at Alvediston. Fined 10s and costs each, or 10 days.

There was a cross–summons against Geo. William Mullins, by Henry Pole: and Coombes summoned Wm Mullins for assaulting him at the same place and time. Case dismissed.

Geo. Wm. Mullins, of Alvediston, was summoned for assaulting William Hellier, in the parish of Donhead St Andrew, and threatening to "rip him up," on Saturday night, 12th November. Fined £1 and costs or three weeks. Paid.
