The Marriage of Joseph Good & Harriet Day

1869

On Thursday, Joseph Good, Esq., MD, was united in marriage to Miss Harriett Elizabeth Ann, eldest daughter of William Day, Esq., of Alvediston House.

The bride, attended by six bridesmaids, entered the church at 11 o'clock, when an appropriate hymn was sung by the choir. The service was conducted by the Rev P S Desprez, assisted by Rev J J Pickford, and the Rev J Smith.

After the marriage breakfast, the newly married pair started for the Isle of Wight, there to spend the honeymoon. Slippers were plentifully showered, and numerous relatives and friends wished the bride and bridegroom, from their hearts, God speed and a happy life.

The bride had numerous and costly presents, which showed unmistakeably the love that was entertained for her amongst all classes. Both the old people and the school children were well entertained in the afternoon, having plenty to eat and drink. A brass band was in attendance.
