

Alvediston - Rate Book 9 June 1899

An assessment for the Relief of the Poor of the Parish of Alvediston in the County of Wiltshire and for other purposes chargeable thereon according to Law, made this 9th day of June in the Year of Our Lord 1899 after the rate of One Shilling and Eight Pence in the Pound on buildings and other hereditaments not being Agricultural Land and at one half of the said Rate on agricultural land, which is estimated to meet all the expenses for the above purposes which will be incurred before the 29th day of September next.
