

Gifts Recorded In The Antrobus Deeds Of Amesbury Priory

10 June 1323

Gift indented (reddiditi et concessi) by John Cittewyne to Henry son of John le Vyvash of 1 messuage and 6 acres of land in Westambresbury, saving to him the customs and services which Henry and his ancestors used and ought to perform thereon and a rights which can fall him by reason of the said lordship. Witnesses: John Goion, 'William Warde, John de Wynterburn, John le Fraunkelayn and Henry de Ambresbury. Ambresbury. Friday before St. Barnabas 16 Edw. II.

Endorsements:

- (i.) A very ancient grant in fee from John Cancelwine (sic) to Henry the son of John le Vyvash of a messuage and 6 acres of land in West Amesbury. Dat' 16 Nov^{ris} anno regni regis Edwardi filii Edwardi regis 6to decimo
- (ii.) 388 years ago

11 November 1375

Grant for 20 years by Robert Fustour of New Salisbury and Alice his wife to William Moiwelese of Neweton Tony of a yearly rent of 20shillings from lands which Margery Vyvash held. of the grantors at Westhambusbury to be held in equal portions at Christmas and Michaelmas.

24 December 1378

Gift by Margery le Vyvash, the late wife of William Robyn of Durnesforde to John Coucheston and William Tannere of Ambresbury late of John Elysaundre of Gormeldon.

3 February 1380

Gift by William Tannere and John Croucheston of Ambresbury to John Madynton of Westambresbury of 1 toft and 6 acres of arable land in the town and fields of Westambresbury, late of John Elysaundre of Gomeldon which the donors lately had of the gift and feoffment of Margery le Vyvash late the wife of William Robyn of Durneforde. Witnesses: John Harwedon, William Harnam, Robert Elysaundre and John Fryssoche. Ambresbury. Friday the morrow of the Purification 3 Ric. 11.
