



Bankruptcy of William Cuss

Salisbury County Court

A Court for the Relief of Insolvent Debtors was held yesterday, before Edward Everett, Esq., when the following cases were heard:

William Cuss, described as late of Ashton Keynes, Wilts, agricultural labourer, was opposed by Mr. Lovett, of Cricklade, on behalf of Mr. Mason, builder, of Ashton Keynes. Mr. Lock, of Dorchester, defended the insolvent, whose debts amounted to £284 5s 11d, there being no assets. This man had foolishly entered into building speculations, and being unacquainted with this line of business he had got into difficulties. He was sent back for six months from the date of the vesting order, which was made on the 19th July.
