GILBERT, ARTHUR CHARLES - Major - 3rd (Penang & Province Wellesley Volunteer Corps.) Battalion, Straits Settlements Volunteer Force - Died 10th July 1943 - Age 43 - Husband of I. Gilbert of Ashton Keynes - Buried at Kanchanaburi War Cemetery, Thailand - Grave/Memorial Reference:- 4 G. 31.

POOLE, ALLAN JOHN - Private 5572128 - 4th Battalion Royal Norfolk Regiment - Died 14th August 1944 - Age 26 - Son of William and Kate Poole of Leigh - Buried in Sai Wan War Cemetery, China - Grave/Memorial Reference:- V. B. 3. - Commemorated on the Ashton Keynes War Memorial, Holy Cross Churchyard - Commemorated on the Holy Cross Church Roll of Honour, Ashton

POOLE, EDWARD HENRY - Private 5182616 - 1st Battalion Gloucestershire Regiment - Died 10th April 1942 - Son of William and Kate Poole of Leigh - Commemorated on the Rangoon Memorial, Myanmar - Grave/Memorial Reference:- Face 12 - Commemorated on the Ashton Keynes War Memorial, Holy Cross Churchyard - Commemorated on the Holy Cross Church Roll of Honour, Ashton Keynes

TELLING SAM - Civilian - Died 16th September 1940 at Rixon Gate, Ashton Keynes - Age 68 - Born 22nd April 1872; Husband of Clara Telling of 5 Siddington Villas, Cirencester, Gloucestershire; Occupation Gardener - Commemorated in the Cricklade and Wootton Bassett Rural District Section of the Civilian War Dead Roll of Honour, St. Georg's Chapel, Westminster Abbey, London
