| Nicholas | Charlotte | <p style="text-align: center;">       In a vault within this Chancel<br/>       Lies the body of CHARLOTTE the 6<sup>th</sup> daughter of<br/>       Sir Thomas Frankland, Baronet and Admiral of the White<br/>       by Sarah his wife who was the daughter of William Rhett<br/>       of South Carolina esquire<br/>       She was born the 9<sup>th</sup> March 1760 and on the 28<sup>th</sup> May 1778<br/>       was married to ROBERT NICHOLAS esquire of this place<br/>       whose family have resided at Roundway in the parish of<br/>       Bishops Cannings in this county from the year 1303<br/>       by him she had issue five sons<br/>       Edward, Robert, William, Thomas and Charles<br/>       and six daughters<br/>       Charlotte, Sophia, Frances, Harriet, Elenor and Maria<br/>       All of whom survived their Mother<br/>       It pleased God that this virtuous, beautiful, and accomplished<br/>       woman should leave her family when her protection<br/>       and example seemed most to be wanted<br/>       yet, with faith in the justice of her maker and confidence<br/>       in her husband's care of those numerous pledges of<br/>       their uninterrupted love, whom it was<br/>       impossible to leave without regret<br/>       she bore in humble hope, a long decay, which yielded not<br/>       to any exertion of human skill<br/>       praying for the blessing of God on her aged mother and<br/>       infant children, and with her last accents<br/>       affectionately calling upon her afflicted husband to<br/>       support her in that struggle which was to dissolve<br/>       an union commenced in the happiest season of their youth<br/>       She resigned her pure spirit to her creator<br/>       on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 1800<br/>       Aged 39 Years     </p> <p style="text-align: center;">       By the side of his beloved wife<br/>       CHARLOTTE is buried the body of<br/>       ROBERT NICHOLAS Esq.
