To the Right Reverend Father in God By Divine permission Lord Bishop of Salisbury. This is to certify your Lordship that we whose names are hereunto subscribed being his Majesties Protestant Dissenting Subjects intend to hold a Meeting for the Worship of God in the dwelling house of Augustus Savoury Jenkins in the parish of Ashton Keynes in the County of Wilts. and Diocese of Salisbury. We therefore pray that this Certificate may be entered in your Lordships Registry according to an Act of Parliament made and appointed in that behalf in the Reign of King William and Queen Mary. Witness our hands this fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven. George Moorhouse?; James Vines; John Rogers; A. S. Jenkins.
