Commemorated in the Cricklade & Wootton Bassett,
Rural District Section of the Civilian War Dead Register

The Civilian War Dead Roll of Honour is housed near St. George's Chapel, Westminster Abbey, London. The register contains the names of some 67,092 civilians of the Commonwealth whose deaths were due to enemy action during WWII. The names are recorded in sections and can also be found in the records of the Commonwealth War Graves Commission. In some cases family members or next of kin are included in the details.
