Listed below is a short biography of those brave souls who gave their lives for their country and are in some way connected to Avebury

ASH, ALBERT - served 1939-1945 - Commemorated on the St. James Church Memorial, Avebury (There is no defining criteria to establish the identity of this casualty with the Commonwealth War Graves Commission Registers)

GREENAWAY, FREDERICK - Private 5566197 - 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - died 7th August 1944 - age 38 - son of William Henry and Matilda Ellen Greenaway; husband of Dorothy Edith Miriam Greenaway of Avebury - Buried at Naples War Cemetery, Italy - Grave/Memorial Reference - I. D. 4 - Commemorated on the St. James Church Memorial, Avebury

HAIG, WILLIAM MITCHELL - Private 1650871 - 7th Battalion Seaforth Highlanders- Died 7th September 1944 - Age 34 - Born in Roxburghshire, Scotland; Resident of Wiltshire - Buried in Leopoldsburg War Cemetery, Limburg, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- VI. A. 14 - Commemorated on the St. James Church Memorial, Avebury

PRATT, SAMUEL SEARLE - Lance Sergeant 835158 - 3rd Field Regiment, Royal Artillery - died 12th June 1942 - age 29 - son of Samuel Harold and Amelia Mary Pratt of Avebury - Buried at Knightsbridge War Cemetery, Acroma, Libya - Grave/Memorial Reference - 3. E. 12 - Commemorated on the St. James Church Memorial, Avebury
