Baverstock

The Rector and Fellows of Exeter College, Oxford, have presented the Rev. Richard Hawkins Hitchins to the Rectory of Baverstock, in this county.

Preferred – The Rev. W. E. Honey, vicar of South Newington, to the rectory of Baverstock, Wilts.

The Rev. W. Hony, B.D., Rector of Baverstock, has been appointed Rural Dean of the Deanery of Chalke, in the room of the Rev. F. Lear, promoted to the Archdeaconry of Sarum.

We feel pleasure in stating that the Rev. William Edwd. Hony, B.D., Rector of Baverstock, Vicar of the adjoining parish of Compton Chamberlaine, near Salisbury, and Prebendary of Yetminster and Grimston, in Salisbury Cathedral, has been named as the new Archdeacon of Sarum, in the room of the Rev. Francis Lear, recently promoted to the dignity or office of Dean of the Cathedral Church of Sarum. The Archdeacon's collation will take place immediately on installation of the new Dean, which is expected in about a week from this time.

On the 3rd inst. the Rev. William Edward Hony, clerk, B.D., Rector of Baverstock, in this county, Vicar of the adjoining parish of Compton Chamberlaine, and Prebendary of the Prebend of Yetminster and Grimston, antiently founded in Salisbury Cathedral, was collated by the Lord Bishop of Salisbury to the Archdeaconary or Archidiaconal Dignity of Sarum, void by the resignation of the Very Rev. Francis Lear,

B.D., now Dean of Sarum, and belonging to the Donation or Collation of his Lordship, by virtue of his See. The Archdeacon was duly installed into the Archdeaconry in the afternoon of the above named day.-

The Rev, gentleman has also been appointed to the office of Official of the Very Rev. the Dean of Sarum, an office held and exercised by the late Archdeacon. – The Vicarage of Compton Chamberlaine above mentioned is now vacant.

APPOINTMENT OF A NEW CANON

A special meeting of the Dean and Chapter was held at the Cathedral, on Wednesday morning last, for the purpose of filling up the Canonry, vacated by the demise of the Hon. and Rev. Frederic Pleydell Bonverie, when the choice fell upon the Venerable William Edward Hony, Archdeacon of Sarum, Prebendary of the Prebend of Yetminster and Grimston, and Rector of Baverstock, in this county. The members of the Chapter present were the Very Rev. the Dean of Sarum, the Rev. Cannon Macdonald, the Rev. Canon Fisher, and the Hon. and Rev. Canon Waldegrave. The new Canon will read himself in tomorrow.
