RECTOR'S LOSS

MRS MANNING'S DEATH AT BIDEFORD

Much sympathy is extended to the rector of Bideford (Preb. W. N. Manning) on the death on Thursday at Bideford Rectory of his wife, Mrs Dorothea Sybil Joanna Manning.

Mrs Manning, who was a daughter of the late Mr Alexander Powell, of Hurdcott House, Wilts, and of the Hon. Mrs Powell, had been in ill-health for some time. Her special interests had naturally centred round the Church, but she had always been ready to help good causes generally.

Her work for the Church included a leading part in the organization of the working party for the parish bazaar, the secretaryship of the St. Mary's Altar Fund, and work for the Mothers' Union.

The funeral takes place on Monday next at Baverstock, Wilts.
