The parish church of Baverstock, Wilts, has lately been presented by Mrs Penruddocke, of Baverstock House, with a most chaste and magnificent silver flagon. Mr Bennett, of Salisbury, furnished this offering for the church and its services. We also understand that an alms-plate was given not long since to that parish by the same lady; it was made by the late Mr Richards, of Milsom-street, Bath.
