(Note: Hurdcott, a Hamlet about 1 mile south-east of Baverstock, in the county of Wilts. There is also a Hurdcott located near Winterbourne Earls, approximately 4 miles north-east of Salisbury, Wiltshire. With some newspaper notices it cannot be determined which Hurdcott is being referred to.)

Powell, rector of Sutton Veney, Wilts, uncle of the bride, John James Unwin Clarke, esq., only son of John James Unwin Clarke, of Kensington, esq., to Caroline Marie Vere, eldest daughter of Alexander Pitts Elliott Powell, of Hurdcott House, Wilts, esquire.
