**Berwick Bassett** or Barwick Bassett, is a township and parish in Calne Hundred, Marlborough Union, North Wilts, 9 miles north-west from Marlborough and 7 south from Wootton Bassett station, with 1,388 acres and a population, in 1851, of 205. There is a church; the curate is the Rev. \_\_\_ Penruddock. There is National school. The living is a donative, with £40 per annum, in the gift of the Vicar of Calne. The River Kennet passes near.

Letters are forwarded by foot post from Swindon. The nearest money order office is at Wootton Bassett
