

Berwick St. John St. John's Lynch Gate



The lych-gate at south entrance of churchyard was erected 1911.

The inscription around the inside timber perimeter base :

“TO THE GLORY OF GOD THIS LYNCH GATE HAS BEEN ERECTED BY THE FREE HANDICRAFTSMEN AND BY THE OFFERINGS OF THE PEOPLE OF THE PARISH MCMXI DVRING THE FIRST YEAR OF H M. KING GEORGE”.
