Chippenham Petty Sessions, Thursday (before Rev. J.J. Daniell and Mr Clutterbuck). Henry Woodman, of Biddestone, labourer, was charged with stealing two bags containing food; also with unlawfully sleeping in an outhouse at Biddestone on the 27th inst. The Bench did not convict on the charge of theft, but ordered the prisoner to be committed for a month for vagrancy.
