Marriage This village was the scene of great rejoicing on Whit-Monday, the occasion being the marriage of Mr. Robert Inge to Miss Elizabeth Bowshire, third daughter of Mr. Henry Redford, parish clerk, etc. The nuptials were solemnised at St. Mary's Church, by the Rev. R. K. Corser. A crowd of people, numbering 200, watched the proceedings with great interest. The marriage of the second daughter of Mr. John Williams, farmer of Bishopstone, to Mr. Jones Williams, late of Ashdown, was solemnised at St. Marys Church, Bishopstone, on the 14th inst. The Rev. Mr. Corsor (who was assisted by a friend) officiated. Considerable interest was manifested by the villagers in the event. The wedding party at the church between ten and eleven o'clock. The choir assisted at the service, and after the ceremony was over the beautiful peal of eight bells was rung. The ringers afterwards thoroughly enjoyed themselves, free of charge at the True Heart Inn. On the following evening both the bell ringers and choir were invited by Mr. John Williams to a supper at his residence, and a thoroughly pleasant evening was spent. **Swindon Advertiser and North Wilts Chronicle, 23 November 1878**
