Death of Mr. Richard Cousins

We much regret to announce the death of Mr. Cousins, of Brentford, but late of the High Street, Bishopstone, who was so widely known and respected amongst the Primitive Methodist connection of this district. He occupied the position of local preacher, and was a leading friend to the Dissenters of the district. Deceased successfully carried on the business of a grocer and baker for many years. He passed away at the comparatively early age of 65 on Wednesday, May 25th, and was interred at the Brentford Cemetery* on the following Saturday afternoon, the Rev. Mr. Rawlinson officiating.
