Blackland is a small parish, a portion of which belongs to the borough of Calne. It is 1½ miles south-east from Calne, on the road Marlborough, in the Hundred and Union of Calne, North Wilts. The church of St. Peter is in the Gothic style. The living is in the patronage of certain trustees, and incumbency of the Rev. William Maurice Macdonald, B.C.L., of Calstone; diocese of Salisbury and archdeaconry of Wilts. Population 72; acres 527.
