1827

On Wednesday the 17th instant died at Bowerchalke, in her 81st year, Mrs. King, relict of Thomas King, Esq., formerly of Alvediston. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 22 October 1827**

1831

Married, on Monday, the 19th inst. at Dinton, by the Rev. Dr. Thring, Mr. William Parham, of Bowerchalke, to Mary Ann, widow of the late Mr. J. S. Rowden, of Fovant. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday, 23 September 1831**

1842

Died on Tuesday last at his residence in Fittleton, the Rev. Thomas Horner South, aged 80. He was seventeen years Curate of the parish, and for more than twenty years Curate of the parishes of Broad Chalke, Bower Chalke and also of Teffont, in this county. Mr. South was extensively known and very much respected through a long life. He was a descendant of the family of Horner, of Mells, Somersetshire, and also of the noble house of Ilchester. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 3 January 1842**

1847

Died, Oct 16, at Bower Chalke, Charlotte Bracher, aged 55 years. She had been a faithful and respected servant in the employment of Mr. Harford, of Broad Chalke, for the last eighteen years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 6 November 1847**
