This is the last Will and Testament of me Tobias Pinchin of Box in the County of Wilts made this twenty fourth day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy six as follows ffirst I give and bequeath to William Daniel and Hester Bates and Daughter of William and Ann Tiley of Sodbury the Sum of twenty Pounds apiece Item I give and bequeath to Alice Bull Widow ten Pounds Item I give and bequeath to Jane Wife of Zephaniah Bullock ten Pounds Item I give and bequeath to my Servant John Snell ten Pounds I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary Pinchin the sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds Item I give to John Baker of Box Cooper twenty Pounds Item as to my ready Money Book Debts

Securities for Money and all the Residue of my Goods Chattells Personal Estate and Effects of what quality soever or wheresoever I give and bequeath the same and every part thereof unto my Sister Jane the Wife of George Gibbons And I hereby Appoint the said George Gibbons and my said Sister Jane his now Wife Executor and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal the Day and Year above Written *Tobias Pinchin*
