



Restoration of the Church Bells

A statement of accounts in connection with this undertaking has recently been issued. It states that subscriptions amounted to £405 17s. 2d., and offertories £41 13s. 3d., and other small items made up a total income of £466 13s. 1d. The expenditure includes £256 4s. 6d. paid to Messrs. Blackbourne & Greenleaf, on account of contract, £42 10s. paid to Llewellyn's Machine Company for repairing and re-fixing chimes and clock, £41 12s. for repairs to tower, tower steps, &c., £42 4s. 6d. for new floors to bell and bell ringing lofts, fixing pulleys, &c. A final instalment of £30 is due to the contractors on the 15th June.
