The images show acknowledgement of a letter and parcel received by W. H. G. Andrews (William Harry George) from his mother Mrs G. Andrews (Elizabeth). William stated he was well and that he would write soon. The communication was signed by William on the 24th September 1915.

William Harry George Andrews died on the 31st May 1916. He is buried in the Baghdad (North Gate) Cemetery, Iraq.
