Bradford on Avon

1850-1899

1858

Ann Payne (33) was indicted for stealing a tablecloth, the property of the Rev. William Popham, of Bradford, her master. She was found guilty and sentenced to six months hard labour. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 25 March 1858**

1874

Committed To The County Gaol, Devizes for the week ending July 7, 1874 For Trial. George Morris, charged with maliciously setting fire to two stacks of straw, the property of James Alexander Wilkins, at Bradford. The Wiltshire Independent 9 July 1874

1888

Bradford on Avon. In the police court, a summons against two lads named Henry Lacock and Charles Davis, for stealing two fowls, the property of George Harman, was dismissed. [1881 & 1891 census suggest the two lads were from Bradford-on-Avon] The Bristol Mercury, Friday, 30 November 1888
