#### 1836

June 11, after a protracted illness of 25 years, Mrs. S. Hart, of Bradford, aged 54. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 20 June 1836

Died, March 2, after a short illness, Henry Tyrom, second son of Mr. James King, confectioner, Bradford, Wilts. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 8 March 1845

# 1846

April 12, at the Countess of Huntigdon's Chapel, Mr. Alfred Mizen, of New Town, Swindon, to Louisa, daughter of the late Mr. W. Barrett, of Bradford, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 16** April 1846

# 1847

Birth Yesterday, at Bradford, the lady of Joseph Balmes, esq., - a son. Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 20 May 1847

May 5, at Bradford, Wilts., Aged 89, Mary. Relict of the late Mr. Thomas Hart, and mother of the late Mrs. Luke Arnold, of Bristol. **Wiltshire Independent**, **18 May 1848**
