



CORONERS INQUESTS

Inquests taken before Mr. Coroner Sylvester:

At Bradford-on-Avon, on Mary Ann Bolwell, aged 4 years. On the 4th ult. the deceased went into the garden and ate a quantity of unripe gooseberries; on returning to the house the stomach rejected a portion of them, and continued to reject everything she took until death ensued two days after from great exhaustion. Verdict, "Died from the deleterious effects of eating unripe gooseberries."
