I give to my daughter Susanna five shilling It. I give to my daughter

Hanah five shilling It. I give to my Grandson John Pittman five shillings It. I give to my Grandson Walter Pittman five shillings It. I give to my Grandson George Pittman five shillings It. I give to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Pittman five shillings It. I give to my Grandson Edward Townsing five shillings I give to my Granddaughter Sarah Townsing five shillings All the rest of myne estate I give wholly & entirely unto Elizabeth my loveing wife whom I constitute and appoint whole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament which I ratify & confirme revokeing hereby all former and other Wills by mee made whatsoever In witnesse whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seale the day and yeare above written
