BLATCH - Deborah Blatch of Bratton, 10th June 1730, son John Blatch 130 pounds, various furniture including "the green bed, a silver spoon and the silver whistle, together with the ball'd gelding" daughter Margaret Blatch 100 pounds, a silver cup, a silver spoon, daughter Charity Crosby, grand-daughter Elizabeth Gaisford (under-age), 25 shillings or "scepter piece" of gold. Her freehold at Westbury called Brick Kiln Malting and orchard, with all the rest of her personal estate she leaves to her son John Blatch whom she makes her sole executor
