BIDGARD – John Bidgard of Bratton, gardiner 26th March 1710 leaves to his brother Thomas Bidgard, and two brothers-in-law Thomas Wempe and William Dredge his woollen wearing clothes to be divided between them; to his niece Mary daughter of his sister Rebecca Dredge, deceased, forty shillings; to Benjamin son of his sister Elizabeth Wempe, forty shillings; to Mary daughter of Mary Dyett two shillings and six pence; to George son of Mary Dyett two shillings and six pence; to his brother Thomas Bidgard forty shilling; to John son of Thomas Bidgard his holland shirt, and to his wife Elizabeth Bidgard whom he makes his sole executor, the rest and remainder of his goods and chattels. Proved 3rd August 1710. Inventory of his goods taken 8th June 1710 amounted to 24 pounds, thirteen shillings and six pence.
