1844

Insolvent debtors to be heard at the Court House, Reading, Berkshire on Friday 14th June 1844 at ten in the morning precisely:- Giles Richman rogers (sued as Giles Rogers) late of Muntrof Cottage. Spring Gardens, Reading , Berkshire. Labourer, previously of 1 Lyndhurst Street, Queen's Road, Reading aforesaid, Grocer and Baker and Dealer in Beer by retail, and before that of Stanley Abbey, Bremhill, near Chippenham, Wiltshire, a Farmer. **Reading Mercury Saturday 25 May 1844**

1863

1864

The Bankruptcy Act 1861. In the County Court of Wiltshire, holden at Calne, in the Matter of John Greenaway, the younger, of Studley, in the parish of Bremhill, in the county of Wilts, Wood Dealer, adjudged Bankrupt on the 18th day of December, 1863; an Order of Discharge will be delivered to the Bankrupt after the expiration of thirty days from this date, unless an appeal be duly entered against the Judgment of the Court, and notice thereof be given to the Court. Dated this seventh day of April, 1864. (signed) *William Rogers*, Registrar. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 14 April 1864**
