1910

The Rev. the Honorable Canon B. P. Bouverie, nephew of Earl Nelson, will be succeeded as rector of Pewsey, Wilts, by the Rev. Sydney Lambert, at present vicar of Bremhill. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette, Thursday, 13 January 1910**

1922

On the occasion of his leaving Bremhill, near Chippenham, the Rev. A. C. Holden, now curate-in-charge of Aust, was presented by the parishioners with Treasury notes to the value of £25, as a mark of appreciation of his good work. **Western Daily Press, Thursday, 5 October 1922**

1940

The Rev. C. A. W. Pain, who was formerly vicar of Powerstock, is now vicar of Bremhill, near Calne. **Western Gazette, Friday, 9 August 1940**

1942

In the Diocese of Salisbury the Rev. C. J. Carrier has been appointed to the vicarage of Bremhill, Foxham and Highway, Wilts; patron the Bishop of Salisbury. **Western Daily Press, Friday, 24 April 1942**
