Letters testimonial comprising copy of a letter from Thomas Litchfield and James Wall, (barbersurgeons) to the (Commissioners of the Navy) certifying that further to the order of the 25 Jan. 1699, they have examined Wilson and found him fitly qualifies to serve as a master surgeon on any of H. M. ships of war, dated London, 27 Jan. 1699; countersigned that Wilson was fitly qualified to practise physic by Cornelius Wooton, M.D., and Boudewyn Andrewes, M.D., 18 April 1700, annotated with fiat of John Cooke, surrogate, 19 April 1700: VX 1A/10/337.
