Letters testimonial comprising copy of a letter from Thomas Litchfield and James Wall, (barber-surgeons) to the (Commissioners of the Navy) certifying that further to the order of the 25 Jan. 1699, they have examined Wilson and found him fitly qualifies to serve as a master surgeon on any of H. M. ships of war, dated London, 27 Jan. 1699; countersigned that Wilson was fitly qualified to practise physic by Cornelius Wooton, M.D., and Boudewyn Andrewes, M.D., 18 April 1700, annotated with fiat of John Cooke, surrogate, 19 April 1700: VX 1A/10/337.
