1823

Married last week: Mr John Hancock of Bremhill near Calne, to Rebecca daughter of Mr William Hancock of Kington. **Hampshire Chronicle Monday 1 December 1823**

1824

Married Oct 1st at St Mary's Church, Aldermay, London by the Rev Dr Wilson, Mr Sidney Smith, druggist of Windsor, son of Mr Smith of Bremhill, Wilts, to Eliza daughter of the late Mr Granville Smyth of Plymouth. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 14 October 1824**

1825

Died the much respected Mrs Hancock of Bremhill, near Calne. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 20 October 1825**

1827

Married: Mr Richard Palmer of Bremhill, Wilts, to Mary Anne Bunner of Bath. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 7 June 1827**

1828

On the 19th ult was married at Bremhill, Wilts, Mr Thomas Rogers, grocer, Malmesbury, to Elizabeth only daughter of the late Mr Rogers, Compton Bassett. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 18 December 1828**

1829

Died yesterday Mrs Vines of Bremhill, aged 71. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 5 February 1829**

On Wednesday morning died at the parsonage, Fordington near Dorchester, aged 84, the Rev John Palmer, upwards of 26 years Vicar of that parish; prior to which he was for many years Rector of Bremhill, Wilts. He was a man of amiable disposition and excellent moral character. It was the aim of his life to be useful in his generation, and to perform, to the best of his ability the high and important functions of the sacred responsible office he was appointed to hold. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 11 May 1829**

On Thursday by the Rev W L Bowles, Mr John Hooper of Lavington to Miss Mary Ann Hancock of Bremhill. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 3 December 1829**

1830

At Walcot Church, Bath, Mr Pegler of Bremhill to Miss Poole of Walcot. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 18 February 1830**

1831

Lately married in Bristol, Mr John Weeks, cheese factor of Calne, to Rebecca daughter of the late Mr Hancock of Bremhill. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 10 January 1831**

Lately married Mr George Gingell of Nash House near Bremhill, in this county, to Miss Pegler daughter of the late Mr B Pegler of Foxham. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 7 March 1831**

1832

Married Feb 9 at St Michael's church, Bath, Mr S Thomas of Tytherton to Amelia Deborah fourth daughter of Mr Thomas Gale of Bremhill, Wilts. **Hampshire Advertiser Saturday 18 February 1832**

Died March 31, much beloved, at his residence Bremhill, Wilts, in his 64th year, Mr Richard Sadler Smith. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 12 April 1832**

Married at Bremhill, Mr G Spackman of Compton Basset, to Miss Seager daughter of the late Mr Seager of Highway. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 17 September 1832**

1834

Married on Tuesday at Bremhill by the Rev Mr Buxton, Mr B B Herring of Chitton Farm, to Elizabeth eldest daughter of the late Mr Woodward of Bowood. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 19 May 1834**

1835

Died on Thursday last, after nine months acute suffering, borne with christian fortitude and which ended in consumption, Anne, youngest daughter of the late Mr Richard Sadler Smith of Bremhill, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 9 April 1835**

In the Devizes Gazette it is announced that John Harding lately died at Stanley near Chippenham. It should have been stated "in the parish of Bremhill". This was the old man, an affecting account of whose life was published by Mrs Bowles about two years ago, and for whom the Rev Canon Bowles, the incumbent of Bremhill, procured a prize from the Bath and West of England Society for having brought up fourteen children without parochial relief. Harding was, when he died, in his 84th year, and continued apparently hearty almost to his last. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 13 April 1835**

1836

1837

At Bremhill on Tuesday by the Rev I Buxtone, Mr Joseph Harris of Melksham to Sarah eldest daughter of the late Mr Woodward of Bowood Park. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 28 September 1837**

1838

Married lately at Bremhill by the Rev F Buxton, Mr John Smith of Bushton to Miss Chesterman of Tytherton. **Hampshire Advertiser Saturday 10 February 1838**

On the 13th inst at Bremhill, Wilts, by the Rev Walter Long, Rector of Callowes in the same county, William eldest son of the Rev Giles Haworth Peel of Avoncliff, Warwickshire, to Julia only daughter of William Whitwick esq of Stanley, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 15 March 1838**

1840

Married Jan 30 at Bremhill, Mr John Pinniger of Cowage Farm to Miss Mary Chivers, second daughter of Mr Richard Chivers of Bremhill, Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 10 February 1840**

Died June 7, much regretted, Mr Joseph Carpenter of Charlcott Farm, Bremhill, Wilts in his 69th year. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 2 July 1840**

1841

Married April 30 at St George's Hanover Square by the Very Rev the Dean of Carlisle, George James Williamson, Esq of Middle Temple, barrister-at-law and of Holywell, Flintshire, to Elizabeth Mary daughter of Henry Hulbert, Esq of Eaton Square and of Bremhill in the county of Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 3 May 1841**

1842

Died on Monday the 29th ult Mr George Henry Gingell of Naish House, near Bremhill, Wilts, aged 41. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 8 September 1842**

1843

Dec 31st at Bremhill, Wilts, Alfred son of William Hollister, esq, of West Clifton, Bristol, to Mary daughter of the late William Coleman, esq, solicitor, Marlborough. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 5 January 1843**

Feb 21 at Christchurch, Derry Hill, Mr Henry Doughty of Stockton, to Elizabeth daughter of Mr Thomas Gale, Mount Pleasant Farm, Bremhill. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 2 March 1843**

1844

Married on the 14th instant at Bremhill, the Rev John Scurr of Newcastle-upon-Tyne. Northumberland, curate of Bremhill, to Elizabeth, widow of the late George Henry Gingell, esq, of Naish House. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 21 March 1844**

At Bremhill church, Wiltshire, on the 14th instant, the Rev John Scurr, fourth son of the late Rev Thomas Scurr, vicar of Allendale, to Elizabeth, widow of G H Gingell Esq of Naish House. **Newcastle Journal Saturday 30 March 1844**

Married April 7 at the Baptist Chapel, Castle Street, Calne, by Mr Lush the pastor, in the presence of the Registrar; Mr Steward Peglar of Bremhill to Miss Elizabeth Hillier of the same place. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 13 April 1844**

Married Nov 23 at Bremhill by the Rev J Scurr, Mr James Bewley of Beaversbrook Farm to the widow of Mr James Besant of Bremhill, Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 30 November 1844**

1845

On Monday the 10th inst, at Bremhill by the Rev H Drury, Mr William Wilkins of Garsdon to Miss Sophia Hancock youngest daughter of the late Mr John Hancock of Foxham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 20 February 1845**

March 31 at Bremhill by the Rev Mr Drury, Mr Thomas Turk of Foxham to Miss Maria Gregory of Spirthill. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 3 April 1845**

1846

Died on Saturday last Mr Joseph Smith of Bremhill near Calne. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 16 May 1846**

1847

April 22 at Bremhill by the Rev H Drury, Mr W Hunt of Keevil wick Farm, to Jane youngest daughter of the late Mr W Carpenter of Charlcutt. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 29 April 1847**

Died on Tuesday the 16th instant, at Naish House, the Rev J Scurr late curate of Bremhill, son of the Rev Thomas Scurr, vicar of Allendale, Northumberland, aged 39 years. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 25 March 1847**

Died Nov 28th in the 48th year of his age, deeply and sincerely regretted, Mr Broom Pinniger Smith, surgeon of St Leonards, Hastings, second son of the late Mr R S Smith of Bremhill in this county. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 9 December 1847**

April 22 at Bremhill church by the Rev William Matthias, William Hole Bethell, esq, of Springfield House. Pilton, Somersetshire, to Ellen Mary youngest daughter of the late William Gent Wood. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 29 April 1847**

1848

Feb 24 at Bremhill by the Rev H Drury, William Prowze Curry, esq, of St John's Wood, London, brother of the Rev H T Curry, Leaven Heath, Suffolk, to Anne, eldest daughter of the late Mr John Hancock of Foxham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 9 March 1848**

On the 15th inst at the Vicarage, Bremhill, the lady of the Rev Henry Drury of a son. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 20 July 1848**

Died Nov 27 at Bremhill, aged 11 years, Emily Jane Gregory. She was attacked with typhus fever on Friday night and very early on Monday morning was a corpse. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 7 December 1848**

1849

Died April 15th at Bremhill, Miss Priscilla Smallcomb, aged 49 years. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 19 April 1849**

On the 4th inst, aged 52, Mr Robert Theobald of Beanacre Farm, Bremhill. The deceased was greatly respected in life, and died in the hope of the Gospel. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 11 August 1849**

Oct 18 at Bremhill by the Rev H Drury, Mary Ann, eldest daughter of Mr Rogers, East Tytherton, to Mr B Rogers, St Luke's, London. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 25 October 1849**

Dec 1st at Bremhill Vicarage, the wife of the Rev Henry Drury, of a daughter. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 6 December 1849**
