1850

Died April 7 at his residence in the Close, Salisbury, aged 89, the Rev Canon Bowles, the eminent poet and formerly rector of Bremhill, Wilts. Mr Bowles was father of the present Mrs Southey. **Northampton Mercury Saturday 13 April 1850**

May 26 at Bremhill Vicarage, the wife of the Rev Henry Drury, a daughter. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 3 June 1852**

1854

Died on Saturday last, after a short illness, Mr Smallcombe of Wick Hill, near Bremhill. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 5 October 1854**

1855

On the 5th inst at Bremhill Vicarage, the wife of the Rev Henry Drury, of a daughter. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 12 May 1855**

1856

On Thursday April 17 at Bremhill Church by the Rev A Make assisted by the Rev C Dawson, Mr John Heath of Malmesbury to Lucy third daughter of the late Mr Christopher Pegler of Foxham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 24 April 1856**

Died April 27 Mrs Theobald, aged 68, widow of the late Mr Theobald, Bancroft Farm, Bremhill. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 1 May 1856**

July 17 at Langley Burrell, Mr R Leonard, wine merchant of Chippenham, to Elizabeth Sara Maria Ann Gingell, only daughter of the late Mr Gingell of Naish House, Bremhill, Wilts. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 24 July 1856**

Sept 21st at Studley Farm, Bremhill, Wilts, Mrs Robert Clifford – of a son. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 25 September 1856**

1859

June 15 at the vicarage, Bremhill, the wife of the Rev Henry Drury of a son. **Sherborne Mercury Tuesday 21 June 1859**

July 26th at St James Church, Bath, by the Rev F Philpott, the Rev Arthur Male Esq, to Fanny Florentina elder daughter of Col Cooper of the 7th Bombay Native Infantry. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 4 August 1859**

Died Dec 2, Mr Edward Fry of Cadnam Park Farm, Bremhill, aged 61 years, much lamented by his family and friends. **Wiltshire Independent Thursday 8 December 1859**

1860

Died on the 1st inst, at Bremhill, near Calne, Joseph Andrews aged 86, a veteran who fought in the battle of Waterloo, and assisted in carrying General Picton from the field when mortally wounded. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 7 April 1860**

1861

Died Jan 15 at his residence, Caden Town, Thomas Eyre Hume Esq, youngest son of the late Rev Nathaniel Hume Rector of Bremhill. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 17 January 1861**

At Bremhill, Wilts, on the 18th inst, the wife of the Rev W H Hitchcock – of a son. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 30 May 1861**

Oct 17th at West Tytherton by the Rev R V Rich, vicar of Chippenham, Mr Thomas White Jefferys second son of Mr Stephen Jefferys of Nash House, Bremhill, to Sarah third daughter of the late Mr Thomas Watson of Melksham and Tytherton. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 24 October 1861**

1862

Aug 12 at St Woolos Church in the county of Monmouth by the Ven Archdeacon Crawley, the Rev William Feetham MA curate of Bremhill, Wilts, to Alice eldest daughter of the Rev Edward Hawkins MA vicar of St Woolos. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 21 August 1862**

1863

January 20 at the parish church Bremhill, by Archdeacon Drury, Walter Alfred son of the late William Turk of Gatsell Farm, to Ellen Jane Fry eldest daughter of the late Edward Fry, Cadnum Park, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 22 January 1863**

Died on Sunday last at the Vicarage, Bremhill, the Venerable Archdeacon Drury. (Aged 50) On the previous Thursday Archdeacon Drury attended a meeting of the Diocesan Church Building Association at Salisbury, and took part in the discussion, apparently in his usual health. He returned to Bremhill on Saturday evening – was soon after taken ill, and died at noon on Sunday – to the great sorrow of all who knew him. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 29 January 1863**

Died at the Vicarage, Bremhill, on Easter-day, Henry Drury, second son of the late Archdeacon Drury aged 9 years 11 months. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 9 April 1863**

1864

April 19 at Bremhill Church by the Rev W Feetham, Mr Henry Knapp of Malmesbury to Emma youngest daughter of the late Mr Christopher Pegler of Foxham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 21 April 1864**

1865

On Tuesday the 31st ult, of scarlatina, at Bremhill Rectory, Catherine, the beloved wife of the Hon and Ven Archdeacon Harris, daughter of the late Sir Lucius O'Brien and sister to the present Lord Inchiquin. **Hampshire Advertiser Saturday 4 February 1865**

1866

At the parish Church, Bremhill this morning by the Ven Archdeacon Harris, Robert Morgan, esq, of Twerton near Bath, to Anne Sophia youngest daughter of the late Mr William Turk of Godsell Farm, Foxham, near Chippenham. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 26 April 1866**

Died June 28th at Bremhill aged 81, Jane widow of the late Mr J C Pocock of Allington, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 5 July 1866**

June 27th at Christ Church, Derry Hill, Wilts by the Hon and Ven the Archdeacon of Wilts, assisted by the Rev H M Fletcher, Incumbent, the Rev Edward Inman, Curate of Bremhill to Eleanora Maria youngest daughter of the late Rev S T Slade-Gully of Trevenen, Cornwall, and Rector of Berrynarbor, Devon.

1883

Died July 17 at Lacock, Alice fifth daughter of the late Mr C Daw, of Manor Farm, Bremhill, Wilts, aged 25. **Western Times Wednesday 18 July 1883**

1888

Died on the 28th ult, Helen Annette, wife of Edward Eddrup, vicar of Bremhill, a canon of Salisbury in her 54th year. **Morning Post Monday 2 January 1888**

1893

Mr and Mrs Alfred Hollister, of Bremhill, Combe Park, celebrated their golden wedding on Saturday, having been married at Bremhill, Wilts, December 31, 1842. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 5 January 1893**

1894

A marriage has been arranged and will take place in November, between the Rev William Brook of St Leonards-on-Sea fourth son of the late Rev Alfred Brook rector of Mansfield Woodhouse, and Ela Grace Elizabeth third daughter of Canon Eddrup, RD, Prebendary of Salisbury and vicar of Bremhill, Wilts. **Morning Post Friday 12 October 1894**

Nov 21 at St Martin's, Bremhill, Wilts, William Brook, Assistant Priest of Fordingbridge, Hants, youngest son of the late Alfred Brook, Rector of Mansfield Woodhouse, Notts, to Ela Grace Elizabeth youngest daughter of Canon Eddrup, RD, vicar of Bremhill. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 29 November 1894**

1895

May 24 at 5, Clive Road, Canton, Cardiff, the wife of Henry Townsend of Bremhill, Calne, Wilts, a daughter. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 2 June 1898**
