Inquest on George Gerrish

An inquest was held George Gerrish, a marine store dealer, who was found dead in Stanley Lane, on Friday evening last. The deceased had been out during the day collecting rags and bones, and at Bremhill was in the company of a man named George Thatcher, who was gaining ground upon him, could hear the rattle of his (Gerrish's) trucks some distance in advance of him, but all at once he missed the sound, and proceeding a little farther he found the trucks upset and the deceased lying on his face in the mud. He spoke to him, but received no reply, and upon turning him over he breathed only once and then expired. Verdict – death from apoplexy.
