Inquest on John King

Mr Whitmarsh held an inquest last Monday at Spirthill, in the parish of Bremhill, on the body of John King, 55 years of age. Thomas Whiteman deposed that on the previous Thursday afternoon he was milking in the yard at Spirthill Farm, when deceased passed by riding on some straw in a waggon. As it was turning a corner into the main road he slipped off and fell to the ground, receiving such internal injury on the head as to cause his death early the following morning. Verdict – Accidental Death.
