**1800**

There is now in possession of Mr George Woodward, of Trembling's Farm in the parish of Bremhill, Wilts, an ewe of a mixed breed between a South Down and a Leicester, which although not 3 years old, had produced seven fine healthy lambs, at three yearlings, which were all reared and proved very good. **Chester Courant Tuesday 8 April 1800**

**1829**

On Thursday night the 2nd instant, a valuable mare, the property of Mr Thomas Gale, overseer of Bremhill, was severely injured by having several sharp instruments run into different parts of the hind leg. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 16 July 1829**
