Death of Edward Champion Long 1921

The death occurred suddenly at Bremhill, Calne, on Sunday of Mr Edward Champion Long (45), who leaves a widow and two children.

Mr Long, who was a son of the late Rev G E Long, formerly vicar of Bremhill, had been in delicate health for some time past.

He was chairman of the Calne Rural Council and was also on the Guardians Committee, and for the past six years he had been a member of the Wilts County Council and Standing Joint Committee.

Mr Long, who was a magistrate for Calne, was a prominent Freemason, being WM of the St Edmund Lodge, Calne, and also an officer of the Chippenham Lodge.

The funeral takes place at Bremhill this afternoon.
